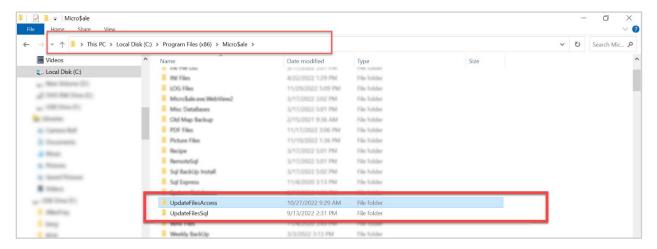
Fixing upgrade errors (hitting errors in the menu, discounts, employees)



Version 9 update files must be removed after upgrading to Version 10

When upgrading to Version 10 over an existing version of software, it is vital that all of the Version 9 update files are removed.

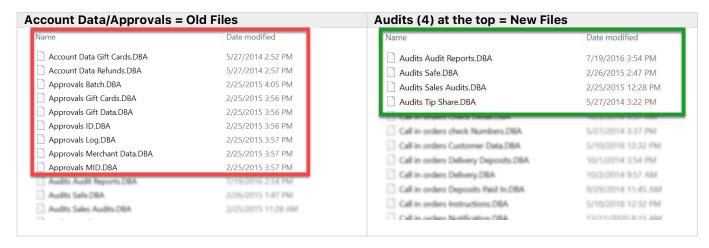
Check to see if Version 10's update files replaced Version 9's by going to:
C:\ > Program Files (x86) > Micro\$ale



- 2. All errors that may occur after upgrading over an existing MicroSale version are fixed within the UpdateFiles folders. These two files control and build the proper databases needed for the software.
 - UpdateFilesAccess
 - UpdateFilesSql
- 3. To determine if the older version's files are being used, click on UpdateFilesAccess.

If multiple Approvals DBAs are at the top of the list, you have old files.

If four Audit DBAs appear at the top, the software is using the latest files and you can exit.



- 4. Delete all components out of this folder (do not delete the actual UpdateFilesAccess Folder)
- 5. Copy/Paste in all components from Version 10's UpdateFilesAccess folder
- 6. Delete all components out of the UpdateFilesSql folder (do not delete the actual UpdateFilesSql Folder)
- 7. Copy/Paste in all components from Version 10's UpdateFilesSql folder
