

MicroSale Version 9

Chase Payment Setup

In order to use Chase Payment as a direct credit card interface within MicroSale, you will need to make sure that the site license has this option enabled as well as you must be using **Version 9.0.296** or higher. If it does not, please contact MicroSale for assistance.

Configuring the system to use Chase

1. Copy the "Chase direct" folder from the FTP Site into the M\$CD folder on each terminal
 - > FTP → M\$CD → Install Files → Interface Install Files → Chase direct
2. Double-click the "ChasePaymenttechSpectrum5.2.0DotNet20.msi" file to run the software
3. Copy the "HTTPSConnectConfig.xml" file to overwrite the existing one within:
 - > C:\Program Files\Chase\Paymenttech\Spectrum.Net2.0\5.2.0\Config\
 - > Note: On 64-bit systems, replace "Program Files" with "Program Files (x86)"
4. Launch MicroSale
5. Go to the Managers Menu → Register Setup → Credit Card Setup
6. Select "CHASE" from the drop-down menu for the "Primary Host Name"
 - > Note: If Chase does not appear within the list, then the license has not been updated or provisioned
7. Copy "CHASE" from the Primary Host Name field and paste it into the Secondary Host Name field
8. In the Merchant ID field enter in the site specific 12-digit Merchant ID Number provided by Chase
9. In the Terminal ID field enter in the 3-digit Terminal ID. Each register will need a unique Terminal ID Number (I.E. 001, 002, 003, etc.)
10. In both the "User Name" and "Password" fields, enter in the data provided by Chase
11. Select the "Save Credit Card Setup" button when finished
12. Repeat above steps on each register
